
#### **Analysis of Pandemic Unemployment Payments**

There are 475,364 people in receipt a Pandemic Unemployment Payment of which 213,153 are female and 262,211 are male.



## **Analysis of COVID-19 Enhanced Illness Benefit**

To date, 120,892 people have been medically certified for receipt of a Covid-19 related Illness Benefit payment, of whom 65,704 are female and 55,188 are male.

Some 9,718 people are currently in receipt of an Enhanced Illness Benefit payment.
