

Update on Payments Awarded for Covid-19 Pandemic Unemployment Payment and Enhanced Illness Benefit – Statistics



There are 481,331 people in receipt a Pandemic Unemployment Payment of which 215,006 are female and 266,325 are male.



To date, 130,434 people have been medically certified for receipt of a Covid-19 related Illness Benefit payment, of whom 70,667 are female and 59,767 are male.

Some 7,149 people are currently in receipt of an Enhanced Illness Benefit payment.
