1. Minutes and Matters Arising

- The minutes from meeting 7 were approved.
- The Secretariat provided an update on the public consultation process and a short overview of the plans for the Stakeholder Forum. The consultation closed on Tuesday 9 March

2. Pension Rates and the Pension Promise

- The Secretariat gave a short presentation on the "pension promise".
- Using data from the CSO Survey of Income and Living Conditions, the Secretariat noted that the State Pension system is extremely effective at ensuring that Irish pensioners do not experience poverty.
- The "pension promise" is that this remains the case for both current, and future, pensioners.
- The Programme for Government states that the core weekly rates will not be reduced. The policy position is that the real value of pension payments will be retained through a process of benchmarking and indexation. In this regard, Ireland is atypical among OECD countries in not having a formal benchmark

in legislation. The *Roadmap for Pensions Reform 2018 - 2023* set a benchmark of 34% of average earnings for the State Pension Contributory, with increases linked to earnings/inflation. The *Roadmap for Social Inclusion 2020 – 2025* set out how this indexation process could operate on a 'smoothed earnings' basis.

- Members noted that an earnings benchmark provides an anchor against income inequality.
- Members discussed the Roadmap commitments and noted that the underlying data used for measuring poverty and earnings made a significant difference in measuring how the benchmark performs.
- The purpose of the State pension and how this is connected to the benchmark needs to be clear.
- Further details were requested on these issues.
- Members agreed that certainty is an essential principle for the State Pension scheme.

3. State Pension Age and Flexible Options

- The Secretariat presented an overview of the 'State Pension Age: Flexible Options' paper.
- The paper set out different options for the Commission to consider in relation to accessing the State pension on a flexible basis, using international examples as a basis for these options.
- The Secretariat also gave an overview of the implications of these flexible options and raised a number of questions that would need to be considered in implementing any of these options.
- Members underlined the importance of this discussion and noted that previous efforts to bring about change to the State Pension have not explored flexible options to any significant extent.
- Members agreed that they will further consider this topic at the next meeting, including in the context of submissions made through the consultation process in relation to the pension age and flexibility.
