

CHECKLIST

Are you ready for an art loan from the OPW State Art Collection?

Ш	Is your building/office an OPW-managed property?
	Are staff (incl. contractors, cleaners, security) familiar with our <i>Information for Borrowers</i> booklet?
	Is your office/Department in this location for the foreseeable future?
	For new buildings/offices: have you completed your settling-in period?
	Has all the furniture you require (incl. any wall-mounted objects) been installed?
	Are you planning any renovations or refurbishment in the near future that might affect the safekeeping of artworks?
	Are the building walls in good enough condition to receive the artworks? Do you need to paint the walls first?
	Historic buildings: have you checked with relevant authorities that you can install art on your walls/wood panels?
	Are there any heat/damp/leak issues in your building that might place art on loan at risk of damage?
	Is the building/office secure and safe?
	Is the building open to the public? Please advise so we can use appropriate fixings for artworks in publically accessed areas.
	Have staff been informed of the loan request and upcoming art installation? Has their input been sought if the loans are for a shared office, for example?
	Do you have on-site storage that is safe and secure in the event artworks have to be removed and stored until OPW Art Management staff can come and collect them?
	Are you prepared to sign the loan agreement stating that the Department is responsible for the safekeeping of the artworks for the duration of the loan?
