Overview of project

- Joint application with Roscommon County Council
- Supported by Bord na Mona and local community
- Just Transition Funding will be used for:
 - Preliminary Design and Environmental Assessment of Trails within BnM bogs in County Roscommon up to Statutory Consent stage
 - Full Stage Consultancy Service for detailed design, preparation of tender documents for conversion of Kilnacarrow Bridge

What is project seeking to achieve

- Creation of a Greenway of regional and national scale
- Ensure the Midlands would become a destination in itself
- Enhance connectivity among amenities and across counties

Project Delivery, Milestones, Timeframes

- Appointment of Consultants to carry out preliminary design/environmental assessments/detailed design
- Milestones:
 - Appointment of Consultants to carry out preliminary design and environmental assessments
 - Achievement of Statutory Consent
 - Consultants appointed to carry out detailed design and preparation of tender documents for conversion of Kilnacarrow Bridge
- Outcomes – Increased length of Greenways ready to be developed, increased visitor numbers to Lanesborough
