Good to hear progress happening and thanks for consultation opportunity .

The DRS needs to be clear, simple, accessible and to reward responsible behaviours.

Can the process not also include a glass DRS scheme and encourage the reuse of glass containers as per milk bottles in the past - recycling glass a carbon intensive process?

I note the competition driven kerbside waste collection system currently in place in Ireland is cited in consultation paper as an additional complication in measuring collection and also limits possible introduction of fines for customers whose waste is contaminated.

Such a pity we can't have a more creative way of keeping a competitive dimension to kerbside collection (if this has to be to comply with some regulations) like competing for areas! The current system whereby we can have 2 - 3 collection lorries all from different companies coming down the same roads on the same days is totally inefficient.
