In response to consultation questions in section 8 of the report;

1. I fully agree with the centralised operational model. But oversight would have to be very robust.
2. Waste collectors - would a new DRS bin be feasible instead of RVM's or manual take back? One that is costed to be a near 0 cost to the end user - basically, the refund per bottle going to the collector instead of the end-user? Seems like a more environmental approach as you don't have each individual person driving their empties to a shop to claim a refund.
3. Communication - advertisements.
