We have read your plans for introducing a deposit return scheme into Ireland and it seems like a very exciting initiative.

The report mentions the possible eventual placement of up to 2,500 reverse vending machines. We have been involved in the transport and installation of many 1,000s of traditional vending machines for over 30 years all over Ireland. We have a knowledge of the site locations and where may suit the immediate location of the first RVMs.

As your committee reviews the options of a central operator, independent contractors or a hybrid of both please pass on our details as we have an unrivalled knowledge base of all the vending operators as well and the scale of this operation will probably require as much collaboration as possible.

We have the logistical expertise with these kinds of machines and the specific Health and Safety clearances that allow us to install across any facility in Ireland. Including our company there are only two others we know that carry the same competences.

We mention this because obviously we would like to get additional business in these difficult time but also because experience has taught us that initial enthusiasm for equipment such as this can quickly be lost if there is not reliable delivery, installation and at times, efficient replacement should difficulties arise.
