## Submission on Deposit Return Scheme

Regarding the Deposit Return Scheme I wish to make one suggestion, as follows:

The ongoing single use of any material, be that glass, paper or plastic etc., will carry an ongoing carbon and resource footprint. Recouping materials for recycling will never achieve the same potential savings of energy and resources as direct container reuse.

Thus I strongly suggest that a glass bottle return scheme be included as part of the Deposit Return Scheme, and that a glass collection, washing and reuse infrastructure be established in Ireland for environmental and employment benefits.
