#### Overview

- > Project Priority: Community Transition Supports
- ➤ Intensify and broaden the current activities of the Community Wetlands Forum (CWF), a special interest group of Irish Rural Link (IRL)
- > Provide a networking platform for community-led conservation groups through sharing knowledge, ideas, research and best practice
- > Empower communities to manage their own resources
- ➤ Build capacity based on local leadership & through supports provided by agencies and institutions
- > Support the protection, management, and wise use of peatlands and other wetland types for sustainable communities
- > Focus on counties Kildare, Laois, Offaly, Roscommon, Westmeath, Longford, North Tipperary, and East Galway.
- > 2.5 years, from July 2021 to December 2023.

#### Objectives

- Promote peatlands and wetland areas as important places of biodiversity and conservation
- ➤ Facilitate the sharing of knowledge, ideas, experience and organisational methods
- > Share the latest research and best practice in peatland conservation and management
- > Facilitate access to national and international expertise, similar networks, and funding opportunities
- > Grow the network
- Facilitate regular meetings, workshops, events and other networking opportunities
- > Target voluntary community groups and individuals in all 8 counties of the wider Midlands area

#### Impact and Outcomes

- ➤ Foster better understanding of ecological benefits of peatlands in terms of biodiversity and carbon stores
- ➤ **Assist** communities to **explore** and find more efficient and sustainable alternative sources of domestic heating
- > Be respectful and empathetic to the strong socio-cultural connection with peatlands
- ➤ Capture a sense of place, belonging and dependency through stories, visual, performing and creative arts.
- ➤ Encourage new community groups to engage with their peatlands to establish innovative and beneficial projects.

#### Impact and Outcomes

- ➤ Build capacity in community-led organisations to enable communities capitalising on the ecotourism, micro-business and social enterprise potential of peatlands
- > Create clusters of collaborating community groups across the Wider Midlands region
- > Provide **support** and **mentoring** from existing established community group members and other stakeholders
- > Share the latest research and best practice in peatland conservation and management
- ➤ Facilitate access to National and International expertise, parallel networks, funding opportunities
