Terms of Reference

- Provide a forum for engagement between Departmental officials and representatives of the Disability Stakeholders Group, the National Disability Authority and relevant Agencies in relation to the implementation of the National Disability Inclusion Strategy (NDIS) in the transport sector at national level, having regard to existing sectoral structures.
- 2. Monitor and review progress in relation to the implementation of actions in the NDIS and other accessibility related Government strategies/plans, where the Department of Transport and/or its Agencies or public transport operators have the lead role.
- 3. Where major cross-sectoral issues arise, such matters will be relayed together with proposed solutions, where possible, to the NDIS Steering Group, through the Department of Children, Equality, Disability, Inclusion and Youth, by the Chair/Secretariat of the ACC.
- 4. Provide a forum for User Groups to refer issues that have not/cannot be addressed at User Group level.
- 5. The Committee will be chaired by an official from the Department of Transport, and the Department will provide the Secretariat for the Committee.
