LOCATION

- Close to Junction 5 on the M6
- Protected historic structure adjacent to a dry canal harbour
- Adjacent to recently opened greenway link to the Grand Canal at Ballycommon
- Adjacent to County Offaly
- Proximity to Bellair and Toar bogs

Modern flexible working spaces in a historic building at a very attractive location

- Fully equipped and universal access for work and community uses
- Insulated to reduce carbon emissions and for energy efficiency and comfort
- Providing start up spaces for small business which can then move on to larger premises
