<b>An t- Oileanach Glic</b>	26/06/2018	Baltimore to Sherkin Island. Cork Harbour inside Camden and Carlile Forts in favourable weather only.
<b>Ku Ee Tu</b>	08/08/2018	On the River Shannon above Killaloe during the hours of daylight and in favourable weather conditions.
<b>Spirit of the Isles</b>	09/08/2018	From Bantry to Glengarriff within a line joining Four Heads Point East & inside Whiddy Island.
<b>Mystic Waters</b>	29/08/2018	In Baltimore Harbour inside lines drawn between the following points. Beacon point and Barrack point and from Long Point to Deelish rock and from there to Frolic Point.
<b>Maid of the Isles</b>	14/09/2018	Class IV Vessel - Bantry to Whiddy Oil Terminal
<b>Glenbrook</b>	02/08/2018	Carrigaloe to Glenbrook as Passenger Ro-Ro ferry service. Ringaskiddy Pier to Spike Island for carriage of cargo not to exceed the max loading conditions of vessel's stabilitybook. Maximum number of passenger 12
<b>Rose of Aran</b>	14/05/2018	Cliffs of Moher, Doolin & Aran Islands in favourable weather only. Vessel is permitted to berth at Liscannor out of service. No passengers are to be carried to or from Liscannor.

<b>Lady Avalon</b>	31/03/2018	Dingle Harbour in a line from Bean Bawn Head to Crow Rock and a line from Crow Rock with Eask Tower
<b>Steren An Mor</b>	31/03/2018	Dingle Harbour with a line from Beenbawn Head to Crow Rock to Eask Tower
<b>Pirate Queen</b>	21/05/2018	From Westport, Roonagh Quay, Cloughmore, and Cleggan to Clare Island, Inishboffin and Inishturk.
