There are 110,770 people in receipt a Pandemic Unemployment Payment of which 50,614 are female and 60,156 are male.

To date 180,159 people have been medically certified for receipt of a Covid-19 related Illness Benefit payment, of whom 96,077 are female and 84,082 are male.
