We are very disappointed with the wording of this Bye Law. It does not offer protection to these unique and special Salmon and Trout Lakes.

Point 1 The waters should be SOLELY or EXCLUSIVELY NOT PRIMARILY managed. this is number 4 on the proposed bye law.

Point 2 This should be a FIVE YEAR plan on the number 6 proposal.

Point 3 Number Seven on the proposed should be removed.

Point 4 Number Nine .It should be made a criminal offence with large fines for having live fish in your possession.

We have lived by the Lough Corrib for hundreds of years and our family and the surrounding families depended on the lake for their food and many jobs in the fishing season . Our hearts are with looking after the lakes but not with this Draft or proposed bye law .
