I hereby object to the proposed bye law for the following reasons

- 1. The listed waters should be managed exclusively for the benefit of salmonoid species. The word "primarily" (number 4 on the proposed by e law) implies that these waters may also be managed for other fish species.
- 2. Stock management plans should be of at least 5 years duration (Number 5 and 6 of the proposed bye law)
- 3. Point 7 of the proposed bye law should be deleted

 The effect of this point would be to transfer control to department civil servants, of a primary development role of inland fisheries ireland. The inclusion of this point implies t that unqualified department officials intend to interfere on an annual basis in the implementation of fish stocks management plans.

This draft bye law would in effect diminish the status of t these unique salmonoid fisheries, downgrading them to the status of mixed fisheries. For the reasons listed above I wish to object in the strongest manner to the imposition of this bye law
