I object to the proposed Bye-Law for the following reasons:

1. In number 4 the word 'primarily' is used. This implies that other fish types may also be managed in these rivers & lakes. These waters should be managed exclusively for the salmonid species.
2. Stock management plans should be for at least five years.
3. Point 7 of the Bye-Law would appear to give control of development of Inland Fisheries to unqualified Department Officials I specifically object to this.
