Re the above public submission I would like recommend the following inclusions to the proposed bylaws as follows:

Re Point number 4: The word "primarily" should be removed as it's inclusion is confusing and open to broad interpretation. "Primarily" should also be excluded from the Explanatory notes section of the bye-law.

Re Point number 7: This should be omitted entirely and stock management control left to IFI who have the science and expertise at their disposal and ultimate control of stock management plans should not be left to the Minister to amend "as he sees fit".

Schedule 1: The list of designated waters should be extended not just to cover the lakes specified but also their tributaries and catchment areas as a lough cannot be properly managed without also managing its tributaries and catchment areas.
