Dear Minister,

1. We propose that the entire section 7 is deleted.
2. We Request the word "Primarily" is removed from section 4.
3. We request Lough Erne (A cross border water body) is added to the list as a designated salmonid water. The Lough must be managed as a salmonid fishery to maintain the status of the SACs designated for Pearl Mussels (*Margaritifera margaritifera*) which require salmon as their host to survive. For example the Cladagh (Swanlibar) river is an SAC tributary of the Upper Erne SAC which has *Margaritifera margaritifera* as a qualifying feature.
4. We also request a copy of the Appropriate Assessment for this regulation.
