Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers, Yachtsmen and Seafarers


Buoy Changes at Castletownbere Fishery Harbour Centre, Co.Cork.

The Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport has been advised that the No. 3 Green Perch at the entrance to Castletownbere Fishery Harbour Centre has been removed due to damage.

The No. 3 Green Perch has been replaced by a 1.5m green buoy in position:

51° 38' 49.387" North

09° 54' 27.41" West

The light characteristic is a green flash every 5 seconds. This buoy will remain in position until further notice.

For safety reasons, mariners are requested to proceed slowly and with caution when in the vicinity of the green buoy.
