Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishermen, Yachtsmen and Seafarers

Deployment of a Marine Data Buoy in the Scotsman's Bay area of Dublin Bay

The Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport has been advised that a Marine Data Buoy will be deployed in the Scotsman's Bay area of Dublin Bay, during the week commencing 27th February 2012. The buoy will remain in place for the foreseeable future.

The intended location of the buoy is:

| Latitude | Longitude |

The buoy is 1.2 metres wide and is yellow in colour.

Flash characteristics are as follows: Pattern 5 quick flashes (yellow) every 20 seconds, with a range of 5 nautical miles.

All vessels are requested to give the buoy a wide berth and refrain from using the buoy for mooring.
