Deployment of ‘Special Mark’ Navigation Buoy off Annagh Head, Co. Mayo

The Department of Transport wishes to advise that a ‘Special Mark’ navigation buoy will be deployed at the proposed Wave Energy Test Site off NW Mayo on the 30th October 2009.

The position of this buoy is **54°13.920’N 10°08.820’W**.

Flash characteristics are as follows: **FL Y 3s**.

The range of the buoy is 4 Nautical miles and the height of the structure is 5m.

The Topmark is a St. Andrew’s cross.

This buoy will be operational for the foreseeable future.
