

## Marine Notice No.28 of 2007

**NOTICE TO ALL SHIPOWNERS, FISHING VESSEL OWNERS, AGENTS,  
SHIPMASTERS, SKIPPERS, FISHERMEN, YACHTSMEN AND SEAFARERS.**

### Monitoring Buoys At Mulroy Bay, Co. Donegal

The Department of Transport would like to advise that RPS Consulting Engineers, on behalf of Donegal County Council, will be deploying a number of water quality monitoring buoys at Mulroy Bay.

From 1st September to 2nd November 2007, two temporary buoys will be located at positions 1 and 2 shown in the table below.

From November 2007, four large buoys will be deployed in locations 1 to 4 as shown in the table below. These will be in position for a duration of 2 years.

1	55deg 11min 25.11sec N	07deg 45min 36.06sec W
2	55deg 11min 51.73sec N	07deg 46min 44.07sec W
3	55deg 11min 12.89sec N	07deg 46min 41.12sec W
4	55deg 11min 19.67sec N	07deg 45min 45.92sec W

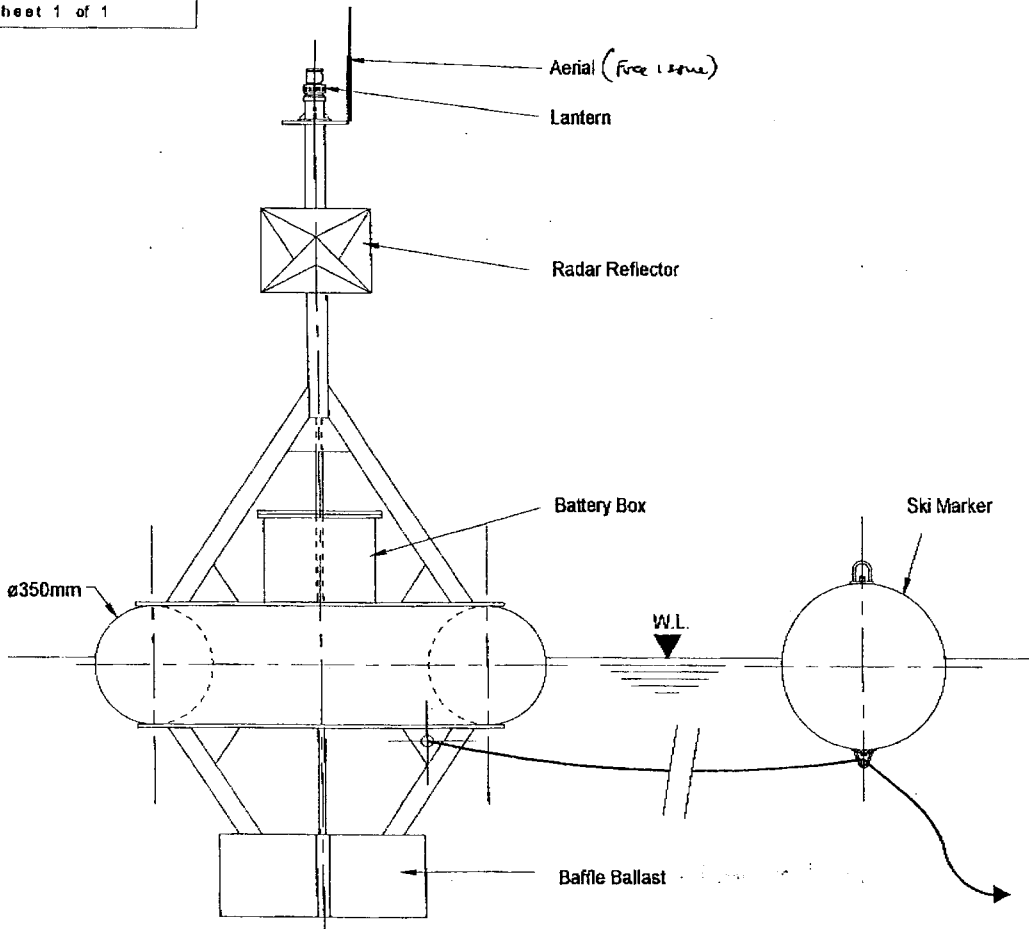
Accordingly, all vessels are requested to give the buoys a wide berth.
