Deployment of Weather Buoy M6 in the Atlantic

The Department of Transport wishes to advise that a new weather buoy, (M6) was recently deployed in the Atlantic by the Marine Institute.

The buoy is located approximately 220 nautical miles West of The Aran Islands at a water depth of approximately 3000 meters. The exact location of the buoy is:

Latitude 53.06 N Longitude 15.93 W

The data of this buoy will be available in the Met Eireann Sea Area Forecast along with the other weather buoy reports.
