I would like to add very little to this but I do think it is important that not only industry sectors contribute to the proposed Carbon Budgets.

I think that it is essential to implement the proposed Carbon Budgets as a minimum. Failing to take this action is just going to make the action we will need to take later more expensive to us all and less likely to be manageable on an equitable basis.

The failure to include in these budgets emissions from international aviation or shipping seem like an evasive piece of creative accounting and need to be re-addressed. But brushing these emissions onto others means that we must accept all our obligations within these proposed budgets.

And to get all of us to accept that what we are doing is appropriate and fair we have to be sure to build a system of communication of these budgets that does not just address the professionals within the affected sectors. The fairness of the sectoral allocations and the subsequent accounting has to be transparent to everyone. And has to be believed by us all.
