## 1. **Respect climate justice!**

The UN says emissions reductions of 7.6% are chance of staying below 1.5C - and that assumption. Your Government promised 7% in the Program. The Climate Change Advisory Council (CCAC) has

7% = Budget of 468 MtCO<sub>2</sub>e to 2030 (-27 corr

7.6% = 454 MtCO<sub>2</sub>e (-41)

Even these are much too large. To do our fair **SMALLER** budgets! Excluding speculative negative emissions, 1.5C is set to be used up 3 years from now!

## 2. **No accounting tricks!**

Carbon budgets should count emissions and must rule out accounting tricks like borrowing (carbon paper) today!
