## Deployment of Wave Scan Weather and Wave Buoy Off Belmullet, Co. Mayo

The Department of Transport wishes to advise that a Wavescan Wave and Weather Buoy will be deployed at the proposed Wave Energy Test Site off NW Mayo on the 9<sup>th</sup> of February 2010.

The position of this buoy is 54°17.145N 10°16.981W.

Flash characteristics are as follows: pattern 5 flashes every 20 seconds.

The purpose for establishing this mark is to acquire wave and weather data for the wave energy test site off Annagh Head and to increase the safety of navigation.

This Wavescan Buoy will be operational for the foreseeable future.

All vessels are requested to give the wavescan buoy a wide berth. A photograph of the wave rider is attached. This buoy is part of the Wave Energy Test Site program and will transmit weather and wave data.
