

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- Development of new economic sectors in areas complimentary to the natural environmental strengths of the Lanesboro/Ballyleague area.
- Facilitate the transition of the economic landscape of Lanesboro away from the industrial sector and towards high-growth markets.
- Accommodate the need and demand for food grade space for existing and future entrepreneurs in the region.
- Meet the need to increase food security by harvesting and processing more locally grown foods.

PARTNERSHIPS

- Premier Lakelands Food Hub CLG specific purpose company established in 2017 to develop projects to prepare the community for economic transition
- Longford County Council original partner in the venture, facilitating the leasing of the proposed site along with substantial financial commitment to the project.

LOCATION

- Lanesboro/Ballyleague is a provincial and county border region split by the River Shannon.
- Lanesboro is situated on the Longford side of the River Shannon, while Ballyleague is on the Roscommon side.
- Approx. 80 minutes to Galway via N63.
- Approx. 90 minutes to Dublin via N4/M4.








BUILDING PLANS

- 13,500 sq. ft. fit for purpose food grade processing space.
- Anchor tenant occupying largest unit of 4,000 sq. ft.
- 4 smaller tenants populating the remaining units, totaling 8,000 sq. ft.





KEY DATES

- October 2022 finalised tenders for both the build and fitout stages to be completed.
- June 2023 Phase 1 build completed.
- December 2023 Phase 2 fit-out completed.
- January 2024 First tenant instated.



FUTURE DEVELOPMENT

- Growth of tenants to expand into potentially additional Food Hubs in the region.
- Develop a mutually beneficial relationship with Technological University of the Shannon (TUS Athlone) who have strong hospitality and food development divisions.
- Collaboration with the 'Taste of the Lakelands Food Festival' to generate a regional centre of excellence for food production.
