

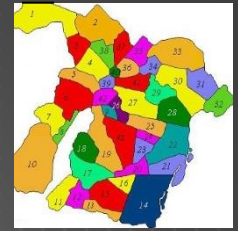

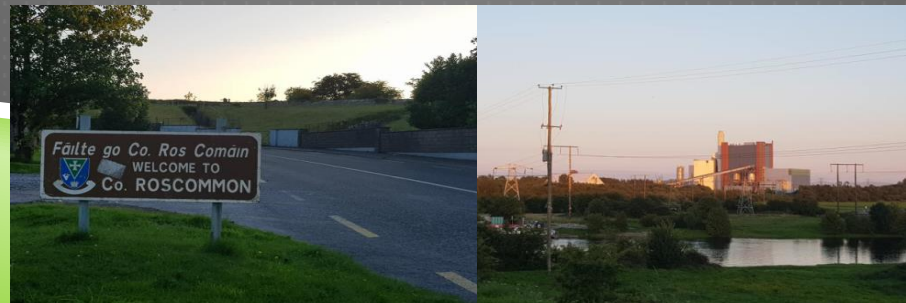

- ▶ Based in a Clár area in rural South Roscommon.
- ▶ Bordering Westmeath, Galway, Offaly.
- ▶ Local community impacted by closure of Shannonbridge Power Station and change in policy and work of Bord na Mona.
- ▶ Local Community Hall upgrade to facilitate education, training, and meet needs of current day.
- ▶ Just Transition Fund part funding specific elements of the project alongside other funders.



PROJECT AIMS TO ACHIEVE

- ▶ Refurbishment of Moore Hall to facilitate provision of a Remote Working Hub and Training Facility.
- ▶ Liaise with the local community regarding training opportunities.
- ▶ Community launch of the new Hub and upgraded Hall.



PROJECT DELIVERY

- ▶ This is a project of the Moore Community Council.
- ▶ A Finance and Hall Committee was set up to oversee the delivery of the project.
- ▶ Following a tendering process, a contractor was secured to deliver the project.
- ▶ Local volunteers came on board to assist with some of the project.

PROJECT MILESTONES


2020

- ▶ Confirmation of Just Transition funding.
- ▶ Works tendered in 2020 and contractor secured.

2021

- ▶ Volunteer work preparing for change.
- ▶ Covid-19 lockdown restrictions introduced by government – shutdown and reopened.
- ▶ Community and online fundraising.
- ▶ Work restarted and near completion.

2022

- ▶ Complete project with sign off from Engineer, Fire Officer, Accessibility Officer.
 - ▶ Launch plans for late 2022.

MEASURING SUCCESS

- ▶ Two rooms added through the re-adaptation of space within the old Hall creating a new working hub and training facility to support local people in education, training, and to work locally.
- ▶ Introduction of fibre broadband - access to the highest standards of communication technology.
- ▶ A refurbished Community Hall – completely rewired and with appropriate doors, extinguishers, suspended ceiling and lighting - all which meets building and fire regulations.
- ▶ Accessible toilet and ramps installed for easy access to the building.
- ▶ Enhanced insulation of rooms and upgrading of porous walls ensuring a Community Hall that has better energy efficiency throughout.
- ▶ Increased use of the Hall by community members to participate in courses, activities, and events.
