MRTT 88: Lough Ree Boardwalk, Ballyleague – Project Specifics

- Cessation of BNM operations in 2020
- RCC seeking to replace revenues and jobs
- Tourism & Outdoor Recreation seen as key economic opportunity
- RCC applied to JTF for Feasibility Study, committing matching funding
- Strand 1 feasibility funding of €90k provided comprising:
 - €76.5k from JTF (85%)
 - €13.5k from RCC (15%)
- Procurement process for Feasibility Study complete
- Feasibility Study Commission Awarded in Q3 2021
- Feasibility Study with input from Key Stakeholders & Community Groups has indicated that the proposed Boardwalk project is viable & should be progressed further
- Proposed project high level cost estimate of circa €3.75m poses significant funding challenge
- Project Risks include Funding, Environmental & Lands Aquisitation





MRTT 89 Lough Ree Boardwalk Ballyleague – Overview & Aims:

- The Lough Ree Bay Boardwalk at Ballyleague aims to create a stunning and quite unique access pathway to Lough Ree Bay, and shoreline. The proposed boardwalk follows the shoreline along wetlands in County Roscommon. The Boardwalk would run for approximately 1.5-2km. This route would provide access to, but not disturbing a natural wetland area which is home to a wide variety of birds and wildlife. The natural beauty of the lake stretching southwards will make a stunning backdrop to the proposed boardwalk.
- Development of local tourism potential to attract visitors to County Roscommon
- Mitigation of negative economic impact of peat fired power stations closure by creating tourism aimed business opportunities
- Provision of amenity promoting active outdoor recreation making Ballyleage a better place to visit, work and live











MRTT 89 Lough Ree Boardwalk Ballyleague – Boardwalk Options Considered

- Support Creation of Tourism Hub on North of Lough Ree surrounded by cluster of activities & attractions
- Significant Increase in Visitor Numbers to Ballyleague/Lanesborough.
- Support & Enhance Existing Tourism activities & attractions
- Be a catalyst for sustainable private sector tourism investment in the region to take advantage of increased tourism numbers
