Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers, Yachtsmen and Seafarers

Corrib Gas Field Pipeline Inspection and Subsea Structure Inspection

1. Notice of Activity

The Department of Transport has been advised that Vermilion Exploration & Production Ireland Limited will carry out a maintenance campaign at the Corrib subsea infrastructure. The works are due to commence in field on **14 August 2022** approximately and will last for up to 21 days. However, please note the start date and the duration of the activity are weather dependent.

2. Location of Activity

The maintenance works will take place at the Corrib field location below and the scope of the works include pipeline and subsea structure inspection. Further information can be found in the map in Appendix 1.

3. Details of the Survey Vessel

The Vessel **EDT Jane** (call sign **5BXW3**) will undertake the subsea scope of work. All equipment used will be vessel and/or remote operated vehicle (ROV) mounted. Visual and acoustic surveys will be conducted by means of vessel and (ROV) mounted sensors. The vessel will be listening on VHF CH 16 throughout the project.




