

Marine Notice No. 61 of 2022

Notice to all Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Small Fishing Vessel Code of Practice Surveyors, Skippers and Fishers concerning **all fishing vessels.**

Mandatory Requirement for all Fishing Vessel Crew Members - basic safety training

The Department of Transport wishes to bring to the attention of all Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Small Fishing Vessel Code of Practice Surveyors, Skippers and Fishers a report published earlier this year by the Marine Casualty Investigation Board into the marine casualty involving the fishing vessel "FV Horizon" off the Old Head of Kinsale, Co. Cork on 14th May 2021. The full report may be obtained from the website of the Marine Casualty Investigation Board at www.mcib.ie.

In response to one of the report's recommendations, the purpose of this Marine Notice is to remind <u>all</u> Fishing Vessel Owners, Operators, Skippers and crew of all fishing vessels of the following:

As required by <u>S.I. No. 587 of 2001</u> – Fishing Vessel (Basic Safety Training)
Regulations, 2001 – all crew members of fishing vessels must undertake basic
safety training.
