





Why is this a problem now?



Atmospheric CO2 levels

Ice ages: 200 ppm

Interglacial periods: 280 ppm

2013: > 400 ppm!

Why?

Due to fossil-fuel burning



Frightening facts!

- * Since the Industrial Revolution, the oceans have absorbed about 25% of the carbon dioxide produced by burning fossil fuels.
- * The waters of the ocean have become 30% more acidic.





More frightening facts!

* Corals which cover only 1% of the world's oceans but are home to more than 25% of all marine species are finding it harder to form their skeletons and are in danger of disappearing altogether!





The Problem




- * We are heading for a mass extinction of animal and plant species caused by **one** species.... **HUMANS!**




