

Marine Notice No. 64 of 2022

Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers, Yachtsmen and Seafarers

North Irish Sea Array (NISA) Offshore Wind Farm - Subtidal Benthic Ecology Survey Campaign - Export Cable Route Area, off the coast of North County Dublin and County Meath.

1. Notice of Activity

The Department of Transport has been advised that North Irish Sea Array (NISA) Offshore Wind Farm intend to undertake a **Subtidal Benthic Ecology Survey** campaign on the proposed NISA Export Cable Route Area, off the coast of North County Dublin and County Meath.

The campaign will involve the deployment of benthic grab, water quality sonde and dropdown video equipment from a survey vessel within the bounds of the proposed NISA Export Cable Route area, detailed below.

The campaign is expected to be completed between **28th September 2022** and **5th October 2022**, subject to weather and operational constraints.

2. Location of Activity

The survey campaign will be confined to the proposed NISA Export Cable Route area. This area forms an irregular shape spanning 11 km north-south and 18km east-west at its widest point. The survey area has 2 landfall areas close to Balbriggan, County Dublin. See map at Appendix 1 below.

The array area is bounded by the following 16 points (Lat/Long WGS 84 zone 30N):

3. Details of the Survey Vessel

The campaign will be conducted by survey vessel **Husky** (Call Sign: **2EQI7**).

An onboard Fisheries Liaison Officer will be available to discuss operations throughout the duration of the survey campaign.

4. Safety Precautions

All vessels operating within this area are requested to keep a wide berth and pass at minimum speed to reduce vessel wash.

The vessel will display appropriate lights and signals.

Mariners are advised to keep continuous watch on **VHF radio channel 16** when navigating the area.
