Marine Notice No. 77 of 2022 This Marine Notice supersedes Marine Notice No. 43 of 2019

Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers, Yachtsmen and Seafarers

Dredging and Quay Construction works at Smooth Point, Killybegs Fishery Harbour Centre, Co. Donegal

1. Notice of Activity

The Department of Transport has been advised that the Marine Engineering Division of the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine will be undertaking dredging and quay construction works at Smooth Point, Killybegs Fishery Harbour Centre, Co. Donegal from **01 October 2022** until **April 2023**, subject to weather and operational constraints.

2. Details of the operation

Plant on site shall include a backhoe dredger, modular pontoon dredgers, split hopper barges, tugs and other smaller vessels. Details of the location where these works are to take place are provided at Appendix 1.

For safety reasons mariners are requested to stay clear of these sites for the duration of the works in the harbour and are requested to proceed with caution in the area of the new pier. Wave wash from vessels should be avoided.

4. Withdrawal of previous Marine Notice

Marine Notice No. 43 of 2019 is hereby withdrawn.
