Just a few observations about this...

I deliver food around the city.

Since the introduction of certain traffic restrictions around the city we have been dumping at least 10 pallets of food every week.

Since a lot of loading bays are now cycle lanes or tables and chairs are using them or DCC have covered them in for people to walk on for social distancing.

So I take chilled food out of my truck in a loading bay further away from where I use <u>to.by</u> the time I get to the shop the food will have defrosted..the shop /cafe /restaurant will probe it with a thermonitor and if it's not at a certain temperature they refuse it...this happens 5/6 times a day..and that just my truck..

We have an average of 15 trucks a day out all with the same result. Just our factory dumps at least 10 to 15 ton of food every month...think what it is country wide .we can't even give it to charities as it's defrosted..

This is thanks to Eamon Ryan who was cribbing about food wastage ,where people on a low wage were buying 2 for the price of 1...
