

### Qatar-Human Rights Record- 3 Lismore

- Children were used as camel jockeys as young as 2-starved to keep bodyweight down!
- -Women convicted of sex outside marriage=1-7 Years in Jail-not believed if raped
- -Restrictions on freedom of expression
- -Patients not speaking English or Arabic do not get hospital care
- Women's pay is 25-50% less than men
- Migrant workers are often under paid- Sout Asians treated poorly
- 6,500 people died constructing the stadiums
- Workers can live with 12 in a
