<b>Naomh Ciaran II</b>	29/06/2023	Between Roonagh and Inishturk, Clare Island, Achill, Old Head , Rosmoney and Westport. Between Cleggan and Inisbofin.
<b>Oilean na hOige</b>	23/06/2023	From slipway Castletownbere or Beal Logh (pontoon) to Bere Island - Oilean na gCaorach Rerrin or Trá Gabhalda slipways
<b>Old Liffey Ferry No. 11</b>	15/06/2023	The River Liffey east of the Samuel Beckett Bridge to a line drawn between the easternmost point of the South Wall breakwater to the easternmost point of the Bull Wall breakwater in favourable weather conditions. Passengers may be embarked and disembarked only at the pontoons on the North Wall Quay and Sir John Rogerson's Quay. The vessel shall not ply east of the East Link bridge when visibility is reduced to less than 100m nor when directed not to do so by Dublin VTS.
<b>Pirate Queen</b>	24/06/2023	From Westport, Roonagh Quay, Cloughmore and Cleggan to Clare Island, Inishboffin, Rosmoney and Inishturk. Old Head. Doolin Pier, to Aran Islands and Rossaveal
<b>Queen of Aran</b>	26/05/2023	From Bunbeg and Magheroarty to Tory Island, with Burtonport as port of refuge.
<b>Rhum</b>	26/04/2023	Burtonport to Aranmore Island, Magheroarty and Tory Island
<b>River Run</b>	13/05/2023	Shannon - Erne waterways Athlone - Ballyconnell - Lough Key
<b>Rose of Innisfree</b>	09/05/2023	Lough Gill and Garavogue River (Sligo) in daylight hours only, in fine, clear and settled weather.
<b>Sea Sprinter</b>	27/06/2023	Roonagh & Clare Island, Inishturk, Inishbofin, Cloughmore, Cleggan, Old Head and Rosmoney, Killary. In fine and favourable weather, during the hours of daylight only
<b>Shannon Dolphin</b>	16/05/2023	Between Killimer and Tarbert
<b>Spike Island</b>	01/06/2023	Within Cork Harbour, inside a line between Camden and Carlisle Forts.
<b>Spirit of Docklands</b>	24/07/2023	Between Sean Heuston Bridge and East link tollbridge including the Grand Canal Basin with minimum air draught of 500mm
<b>Spirit Of Killaloe</b>	22/05/2023	Lough Derg, north of Killaloe Bridge in daylight hours only and in fine and favourable weather
<b>Spirit of Kinsale</b>	14/06/2023	Within a line from Blockhouse Point and Summer Cove in daylight hours. Within a line from Moneypoint to Carrigrone in favourable weather conditions and daylight hours.
<b>Spirit of Lough Swilly</b>	16/05/2023	Buncrana to Rathmullan

<b>St Columba</b>	03/05/2023	Lough Derg, St Patrick's Purgatory, to and from Station Island in settled favourable weather. Vessel may operate during the hours of darkness between the approved piers, only when all pier markers are clearly visible.
<b>St Davog</b>	03/05/2023	Lough Derg, St Patrick's Purgatory, to and from Station Island in favourable weather and daylight hours only.
<b>Steren An Mór</b>	02/05/2023	From Bantry or Glengarriff: Within a line joining Four Heads Point East and inside Whiddy Island
<b>Thor</b>	18/08/2023	Grand Canal Basin between sunrise and sunset. Wind not exceeding 25 knot. Sea state not exceeding 300 mm
<b>Tormore</b>	26/05/2023	Between Roonagh and Inishturk, Clare Island, Achill, Old Head , Rosmoney and Westport. Between Cleggan and Inisboffin.
<b>Tranquility</b>	06/06/2023	Between Doolin, Galway Harbour, Rossaveal, Ballyvaughan, Cliffs of Moher (not within 0.5 miles of cliff base) and the Aran Islands. No cargo to be carried.
<b>True Light</b>	15/07/2023	Roonagh to Clare island Inish Turk, Achill Island, Cleggan to Inishboffin. 3 miles to sea, 15 miles from point of departure.
<b>Yoker Swan</b>	18/05/2023	Between Baltimore and Sherkin Island
