Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers, Yachtsmen and Seafarers

Corrib Gas Field Main Umbilical Rock Placement

1. Notice of Activity

The Department of Transport has been advised that Vermilion Exploration & Production Ireland Limited will carry out a maintenance campaign at the Corrib subsea infrastructure. The work is due to commence in the field on **25 June 2023** and will last for approximately **3 days**. However, please note the start date and the duration of the activity are subject to weather and operational constraints.

2. Location of Activity

The maintenance works will take place within the Corrib field location. The scope involves spot rock placement along the Corrib main umbilical between the coordinates listed in the table below. (Please also refer to the map in Appendix 1 and rock placement overview in Appendix 2.)

3. Details of the Survey Vessel

The vessel **FFPV Stornes** (**Call Sign: PCKX**) will undertake the subsea scope of work. The vessel will operate during day and night hours, displaying all appropriate lights and signals while carrying out rock placement activities using a fall-pipe system and associated acoustic survey equipment.

All equipment will be vessel and/or remote operated vehicle (ROV) mounted. Visual and acoustic surveys will be conducted by means of vessel and ROV mounted cameras and sensors. The vessel will be listening on VHF CH 16 throughout the project.


