

Marine Notice No. 48 of 2023

Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers, Warranted Pilots, Yachtsmen and Seafarers navigating within Dublin Port

Dublin Port Volvo Dun Laoghaire Regatta Closure of South Buford Traffic Separation Scheme

The Department of Transport has noted that Dublin Port has issued two notices to mariners in relation to the Volvo Dun Laoghaire Regatta.

Notice 41 of 2023 advises that the Volvo Dun Laoghaire Regatta will be held in the southern part of Dublin Bay from Thursday, 6 July to Sunday, 9 July 2023 and is expected to attract in excess of 400 competing boats. The Notice advises that the South Burford Traffic Separation Scheme will be closed to all commercial traffic Thursday, 6 July between 12:00 and 18:30 and Friday 7, Saturday 8 and Sunday 9 July between 10:00 and 18:30. Vessels arriving or departing Dublin Bay, including to/from the anchorage, during these times must use the North Burford Traffic Separation Scheme.

Notice <u>42 of 2023</u> advises that five temporary inflatable yacht racing marks will be deployed within Dublin Bay during the regatta and sets out the coordinates for their deployment.

Mariners should consult the two notices to mariners linked above on the Dublin Port website for full details.
