Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers, Yachtsmen and Seafarers

# Sceirde Rocks Windfarm Project – Geophysical Survey

## 1. Notice of Activity

The Department of Transport has been advised by Fuinneamh Sceirde Teoranta (FST) that a geophysical seabed survey will take place in the Western Coastal Area Connemara / Outer Galway Bay / Atlantic Ocean between **5 September 2023** and **31 October 2023**, subject to weather and operational constraints.

## 2. Location of Activity

The equipment will be deployed within the bounds of the area detailed in the table below.

# 3. Details of Survey Vessels

The Geophysical Survey will take place using the following vessels:

• Roman Rebel – (call sign: 2ICA5) is a Research and Survey Vessel. This vessel will operate up to 24 hours per day.

• Lady Kathleen – (call sign: EIXT2); is a research/survey Vessel This vessel will operate up to 24 hours per day.

# 4. Safety Precautions

Throughout operations, the vessels will display the appropriate lights and shapes as required under the COLREGS Rule 27 (b). During operations, the vessels will be restricted in their ability to manoeuvre. Radio transmissions will be conducted with other seafarers to notify them of the operations. Vessels are requested to leave a wide berth during the deployment operations due to the nature of the operations and the vessels' limited manoeuvrability. The vessels will be monitoring **channel 16** at all times for safety purposes.
