## Authorisation Form to allow Registered Forester(s) to act on behalf of a Forestry Scheme Applicant

To the Applicant,

Please complete the application form (page 1) if you wish to authorise the Forestry Company listed and its Registered Foresters to complete and submit your Forestry Scheme application form(s) online to the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine on your behalf with effect from 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023. Please ensure that the data you provide on the form is complete and accurate. Incomplete forms will be returned, thereby delaying this registration process.

The agreement between you and the Registered Forester(s) will remain in place until such time as either party notifies the Department in writing that the agreement is terminated.

In order that your Authorised Forester can act on your behalf in this matter, and thereafter for the purpose of the submission of your Forestry details in such format as may be required from time to time by the Department, those Registered Forester(s) will have access to all Pre-approval applications received by this Department on or 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023 where that Registered Forester continues currently to be employed by the same Forestry Company.

The Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine shall not be liable for any direct or indirect loss or liability to the client resulting from the use by a Forestry Company/Forester of the Forestry Online Internet application to submit a Forestry application on behalf of a client. Full responsibility for the data submitted online rests with the Forestry Company/Registered Forester and the client concerned. The Department will issue an official acknowledgement on receipt of your online application.

It is the Department's intention that all forestry licence applications will be made available through an online portal called the Forestry Licence Viewer (FLV). All forestry licence applications are subject to public consultation. The Department publishes lists of forestry licence applications and decisions on their website. The FLV will also display such information. The FLV will provide interested parties with application information, which will enable their participation in the decision-making process. The application information displayed in the FLV will include applicant name(s) and address(es) along with other application information. Those who make submissions on forestry licence applications will also have their submission, name and address displayed.

## **Declaration by Beneficiary**

"/We understand that in accordance with the European Union Guidelines for State Aid in the agriculture and forestry sector and in rural areas 2023 - 2027, data of beneficiaries of funding under the Forestry Programme 2023 - 2027 will be published and may be processed by auditing and investigating bodies of the European Union. Ireland will publish information on State Aid schemes. This will include the full text of the notified aid scheme and its implementing provisions, the granting authority, the names of the individual beneficiaries, the form (in particular the aid instrument) and amount of the aid granted to each beneficiary, the date of granting, the type of undertaking (SME/ large enterprise), the region (at NUTS level II) in which the beneficiary is located and the principal economic sector in which the beneficiary has its activities, at NACE group level. This will only apply to beneficiaries where the cumulative aid amount granted at financial approval is greater than €10,000 for beneficiaries active in primary agriculture production and €100,000 for others for the amount of aid granted at the time of financial approval discounted at the rate applicable at the time

Such information will be published within six months of the granting decision has been taken and will be kept for at least 10 years and shall be available for the general public without restrictions. These records must be maintained for 10 years from the date of award of the aid and must be provided to the Commission upon request.

I/We also understand that all personnel data will be processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1988 to 2018 and the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)."
