<b>Aareton</b>	30/11/2023	Within fifteen miles (exclusive of any smooth waters or partially smooth waters) from Carlingford Lough, Port Oriel, Skerries, Dundalk and Malahide within three miles from land.
<b>Adventure Express</b>	28/11/2023	3 miles to sea and 15 miles from point of departure. Departure points: Aran Islands, Rossaveal, Liscannor, Doolin, Ballyvaughan and Galway.
<b>Agnes Olibhear</b>	31/10/2023	Within three miles of land and 15 miles from the designated point of departure.
<b>Aquatay</b>	20/10/2023	Up to 3 miles to sea and 15 miles from Howth.. The embarkation and disembarkation of passengers is only permitted from the West Pier steps at Howth (or pontoon). Passengers must be returned to Howth to point of departure. Vessel restricted to daylight operation only.
<b>Blue Skies</b>	15/10/2023	Limited to research use up to three miles from land from various locations around the state
<b>Blue Spirit</b>	24/01/2024	Up to 30 miles from point of departure being Ardroom Harbour
<b>Bundoran Star</b>	17/10/2023	WITHIN A RADIUS OF 30 MILES FROM POINT OF DEPARTURE. BUNDORAN, KILLYBEGS, MULLAGHMORE & TEELIN DURING SUMMER MONTHS OF APRIL 1st TO 31st OCTOBER, AND WITHIN 15 MILES OF THESE POINTS IN WINTER.
<b>Caitlin Marie</b>	31/10/2023	Within 30 mile radius of Kincasslagh and the following embarkation points. Bunbeg, Burtonport, Arranmore Island and Tory Island
<b>Calla Supporter</b>	29/11/2023	Within Smooth and Partially smooth waters of Galway Bay
<b>Canna</b>	31/10/2023	Burtonport to Arranmore. Magheraroarty to Tory Island. Roonagh and Cloughmore to Clare Island

<b>Claggan Ferry</b>	09/11/2023	Achill sound - north of Darby's point to 54 Deg North (In way of bulls mouth)
<b>CS I 1</b>	18/12/2023	Smooth and Partially smooth waters of Civil Defense Cork South operational areas.
<b>CS R 1</b>	18/12/2023	Smooth and Partially smooth waters of Civil Defense Cork South operational areas
<b>Deep Blue</b>	28/11/2023	Within fifteen miles from point of departure, Killybegs, Teelin, Mullaghmore, Burtonport, Downings, Ballyglass and within three miles from land.
<b>DPC Tolka</b>	06/11/2023	Within 30 miles from land. Ports of Departure: Dublin, Dun Laoghaire, Dundalk, Howth, Malahide & Greystones.
<b>Elaine M</b>	31/10/2023	Inland waterways of the state and smooth and Partially smooth water as designated by M Notice 23 of 2023 (Port and sea areas.)
<b>Elisa</b>	18/01/2024	No more than 30 miles from point of departure.
<b>Excalibur</b>	31/10/2023	Within a ten mile radius from Dun Chaoin and Dingle, operating in favourable weather and good visibility
<b>Fomaire Gannimh</b>	20/11/2023	South of a line from Dooniver Point slipway to Innishbiggle slipway and Gubnadoogha Slipway on Innishbiggle to Dorans Point Slipway and North of Achail Sound in Favourable weather and daylight hours only.
<b>Galway Girl</b>	08/11/2023	30 mile radius to sea from Rossaveel, Galway Docks and Kilronan
<b>Gaviota</b>	22/11/2023	Within 15 miles from point of departure whilst within 3 miles from land. Points of Departure: Carlingford, Port Oriel, Skerries, Howth, Dun Laoghaire, Greystones, Wicklow and Arklow. Master to board passengers only where safe means of access is provided.

<b>Gemini II</b>	03/11/2023	FROM BUNAGEE PIER AND RATHMULLEN CO DONEGAL NOT MORE THAN 3 MILES TO SEA AND 15 MILES FROM POINT OF DEPARTURE IN FAVOURABLE WEATHER.
<b>Gwen Bleiz</b>	25/11/2023	Cork Harbour, - areas of smooth and partially smooth waters, in favourable weather and sea conditions. Between the period April 1st to October 31st.
<b>IFI Delta 10</b>	19/10/2023	Coast of Ireland within 12 miles while on IFI patrol duties in accordance with Safety Operational Plan.
<b>IFI Delta 7</b>	14/11/2023	Coast of Ireland within 12 miles while on IFI patrol duties in accordance with Safety Operational Plan.

<b>Kerry Colleen II</b>	11/10/2023	Within a radius of 30 miles from Fenit
<b>Lady Helen</b>	21/11/2023	CLEW BAY EAST OF A LINE FROM ACHAILLBEAG ISLAND TO CLARE ISLAND PIER, TO ROONAGH PIER IN FAVOURABLE WEATHER ONLY. 15 MILES FROM PORT OF DEPARTURE AND 3 MILES TO SEA.
<b>Lantern II</b>	31/10/2023	Within 30 mile radius to sea from Bantry.
<b>Lightening</b>	22/12/2023	Within fifteen miles (exclusive of any smooth waters or partially smooth waters) from their designated points of departure and within three miles from land
<b>Little Trinity</b>	16/10/2023	Lough Key and River Shannon as far as Carrick on Shannon
<b>Lochlann</b>	20/12/2023	No more than 3 miles to sea and 15 miles from point of departure
<b>Maeve Óg</b>	20/02/2024	River Blackwater above Youghal

<b>Marber Therese II</b>	31/10/2023	Up to 30 miles from Portmagee
<b>Mareel Olive</b>	01/11/2023	Smooth and Partially smooth waters, Dublin port harbour limits or to sea. Departure point Dublin Port.
<b>Marine Bravo</b>	21/11/2023	Domestic voyages in smooth waters, in partially smooth waters, within harbour limits, or to sea in the course of which this boat is within half a nautical mile, exclusive of any smooth or partially smooth waters, from the point of departure.
<b>Mourne Pride</b>	18/11/2023	From Greenore and Dundalk, Co. Louth Not More Than 15 Miles from the point of departure and 3 miles from land In: Favourable weather in connection with pilotage operations
<b>Naomi Leigh</b>	31/10/2023	30 miles to sea from the following departure pints: Malahide. Howth and Dun Laoghaire, Co. Dublin
<b>Oriel</b>	17/10/2023	Vessel to be operated no more than 3 miles from land / 15 miles from Howth, point of departure in daylight and favourable weather. The embarkation and disembarkation of passengers is only permitted from the designated passenger vessel pontoon or as agreed by the Harbour Master. Landing at Irelands Eys, L1 & L2 subject to the conditions in the attached Opertonal Landing Plan. *2 crew members required for landing of passengers on Ireland's Eye, as stated in the Operational Landing Plan - passenger number to be reduced to 9 for such landing trips.

<b>Rukini</b>	08/11/2023	Within fifteen miles from their designated point of departure, and within three miles from land. Points of departure; Belmullet, Blacksod, Ballyglass, Killala, Westport Quay, Roonagh, Cleggan.
<b>Sailfish II</b>	31/10/2023	Up to 30 miles from nominated points of departure Kilrush, Kilkeel & Fenit.
<b>Saoirse na Mara II</b>	27/11/2023	From Magheroarty pier to Inish Bofin not more than 15 miles from point of departure and 3 miles from land in Favourable weather.
<b>Sea Safari 4</b>	10/10/2023	Lough Corrib
<b>Seafari 1</b>	17/11/2023	No more than 3 miles to sea and 15 miles from point of departure Baltimore, Cape Clear, Crookhaven, Union Hall, Glandore Crosshaven, Schull
<b>Shamrock I</b>	21/11/2023	WITHIN 15 MILES FROM ROIGH PIER, CORRAUN PIER, CLARE ISLAND PIER AND PORTEEN PIER [EXCLUSIVE OF ANY SMOOTH WATER OR PARTIALLY SMOOTH WATERS] AND WITHIN 3 MILES TO SEA.
<b>Skellig Dawn</b>	10/03/2024	No more than 3 miles to sea and 15 miles from point of departure, Inishboffin, Cleggan and Clifden
<b>Skellig Venture</b>	19/10/2023	Within 30 mile radius of Portmagee, Cahirciveen and Knightstown.
<b>Stephenie</b>	15/10/2023	Loading passengers at Maghergallon and Bunbeg Piers, cruseing within Gwedore harbour and River, staying within a line between Inishinny and Maghergallon pier head.
<b>The Cricket</b>	15/10/2023	20 MILES RADIUS TO SEA OUT OF BUNBEG, AND MAGHERAGALLON PIER

<b>Three Fevers IV</b>	12/10/2023	Killkeran Bay to Achill sound, Loading passengers at Killkeran Pier, Roundstone Pier, Ballyconnelly Pier, Innisboffin Island , Inish Turk, Clare Island, Cleggan , Roonagh Pier, Rosmoney Pier and Westport 3 miles to sea and 15 miles along the coast from port areas in Marine Notice 41 of 2022 between Kenmare river and Youghal. Passengers must disembark at the place they boarded the vessel

<b>Unnamed vessel for Publication</b>	24/11/2023	Limited to Harbour operational areas and Inland Waterways within half a mile from point of departure
<b>Western Kingfisher</b>	18/10/2023	Within a 30 mile radius of Cleggan Co. Galway
<b>Whaly 435R</b>	05/10/2023	Points of Departure Greystones Wicklow and surrounding areas of operation smooth waters. Inland waterways & Lakes Co.wicklow
