I recently visited the power stations Moneypoint (located in Co.Clare) and Tarbert (located in Co.Kerry) during a school climate action trip.
We also met with a local activist who has been fighting against the Shannon LNG site proposal for 15 years. It disgusts me to think that another power station of this scale is currently being planned to be built on the Shannon Estuary. Moneypoint and Tarbert are already producing huge amounts of energy in the Shannon Estuary, so Shannon LNG is CERTAINLY not required to help supply out energy needs in the future and we need to invest in other more sustained energy sources.
