The River Lee quota is divided between commercial 75% and 25% angling, this should be divided more equal.

The River Blackwater is open but the four tributes rivers Bride C&R

Lickey closed

Tourig closed

Womanagh closed this make this system a mix stock fisheries therefore the commercial sector shouldn't be operating here as no survey carried out on what fish the sector is taken.
