I have read the Deposit Return Scheme Consultation Document on a Legislative Framework April 2021 and note that the proposed Regulations, will oblige beverage producers who place PET plastic bottles on the market to become a member of, and fund, through membership fees, a scheme approved by the Minister to operate a DRS in Ireland.

- 1. We trust that consideration will be given in the fee model to differentiating between producers who use recycled PET from those who continue use virgin PET
- 2. It is considered that, in the absence of a short to medium term alternative to the use of PET bottles, that an incentive to producers to incur the higher cost of using recycled PET which could be off-set against their DRS fee obligations, would be welcomed within the sector and would further promote the use of recycled PET and the DRS scheme as part of a wider circular economy policy
