Notice to all Shipowners, Operators, and Masters of Passenger and Cargo Vessels and Self-Propelled Mobile Offshore Drilling Units

Long Range Identification and Tracking of Ships (LRIT) Authorised Testing Application Service Providers

1. LRIT

Shipowners, operators and masters are reminded of their obligations under Regulation 19-1 of Chapter V of the Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea and in particular to the circular issued by the Maritime Safety Committee of the IMO on 9 June 2009 (MSC.1/Circ.1307) in relation to Guidance on the Survey and Certification of Compliance of Ships with the Requirement to Transmit LRIT Information, which sets out the requirements for onboard provision and testing of functional LRIT systems.
