Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers, Yachtsmen and Seafarers

Celtic Interconnector Project Surveys – south-east coast of Ireland

1. Notice of Activity

The Department of Transport has been advised that Next Geosolutions will perform Shallow Geotechnical surveys, pUXO ID surveys and KP5 Omega Loop surveys as part of the Celtic Interconnector Project cable route between the south-east coast of Ireland and the coast of France. The survey is expected between the dates of **6 April 2024 and 2 June 2024**, subject to weather and operational constraints.

2. Location of Activity

The survey operations will be conducted within the cable corridor extending +/-50m each side of planned cable centreline. The survey locations are at the waypoints detailed in the tables below and in the maps provided in the appendices to this Marine Notice.

3. Details of Survey Vessel

The survey vessel “**NG Worker**” (callsign: **ICID**) will carry out the survey works. Mariners are advised to provide a wide berth and navigate with caution in the area. During survey operations, the vessel will keep a listening watch on VHF channel 16 and will actively transmit an Automatic Identification System (AIS) signal. A listening watch will also be maintained on VTS VHF Channels as appropriate. The survey vessel shall broadcast daily, and at shorter intervals as may be required by passing traffic, the vessel position, operational information, and planned operations for the

next twenty-four hours. It is requested that fixed fishing gear within 1000m of the route centreline be removed.

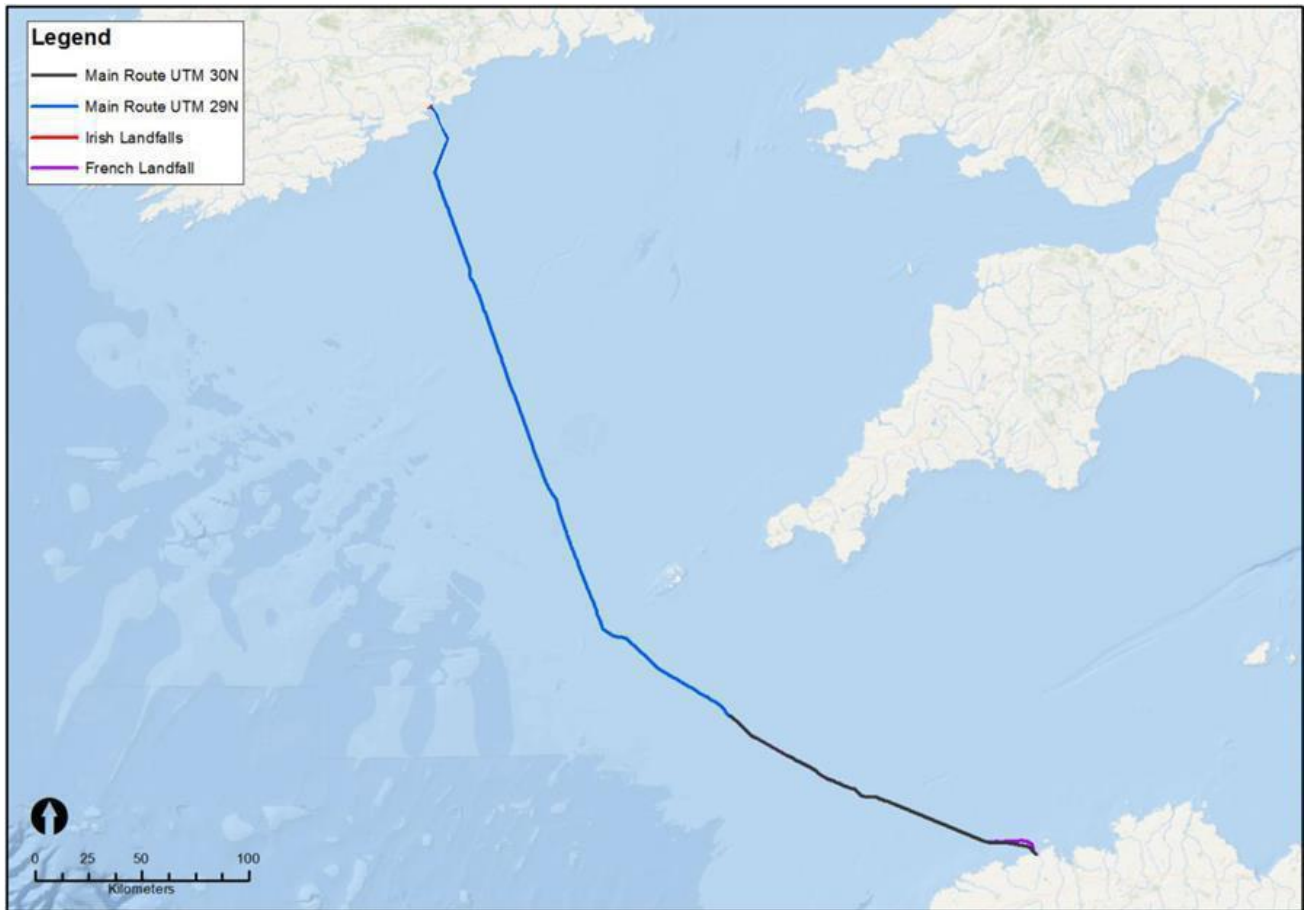
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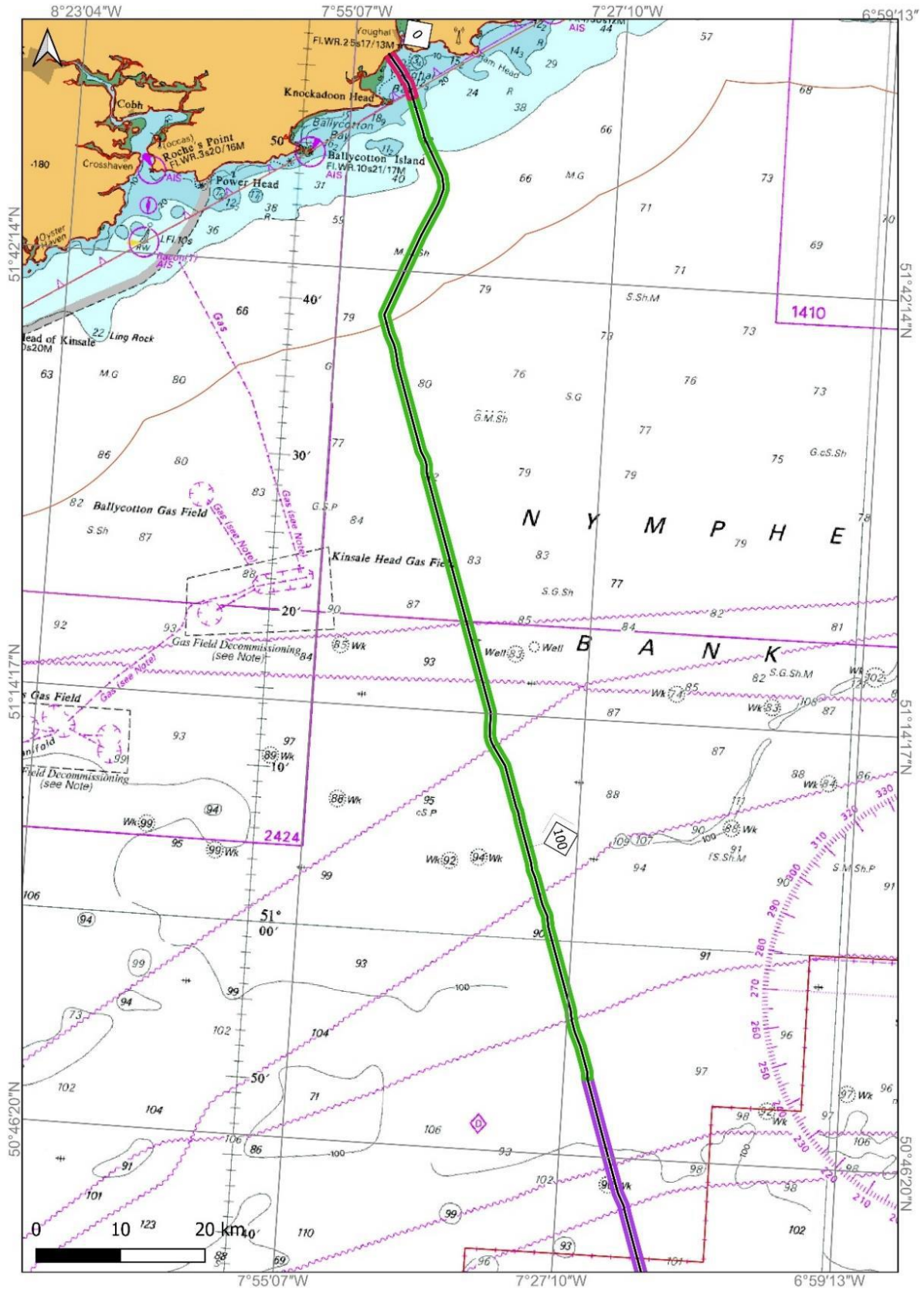
