## **Footnotes:**

- 1. MPV is a Mechanically Propelled Vehicle. Under Irish Law, MPVs cover most road going vehicles cars, motorbikes, vans, trucks, buses etc.
- 2. Cycle Lanes should be used where provided over other road types.
- 3. Commencement date for e-scooter regulations 20th May 2024.
- 4. Safety equipment is recommended and strongly advised Bicycle Helmet and Reflective High-Visibility clothing.
- 5. Commencement date for e-bike/e-moped provisions in Road Traffic and Roads Act 2023 20th May 2024.
- 6. Appropriate vehicle EU Category L type approval required EU Regulation 168/2013 Annex I Vehicle Classification.
- 7. Pedal Assisted vehicles exempted from insurance requirements by EU Motor Insurance Directive
- 8. A motorcycle helmet is legally required. Reflective High-Visibility gear and protective clothing is strongly recommended.
- 9. Driving Licence exemption included in Road Traffic Act 2024.
- 10. A 2-wheel moped is also known as a Speed Pedelec or an S-Pedelec.
- 11. Appropriate Category AM Driving Licence is required Types of driving licence categories in Ireland (rsa.ie)
- 12. A powered electric bicycle or e-moped where power is provided by an electric engine and where a throttle can be used instead of pedalling.
