Skillnet Ireland is the national workforce development agency, responsible for advancing the competitiveness, productivity and innovation of businesses through enterprise-led talent development.

Skillnet Ireland partners with 57 industry bodies, supporting over 22,500 businesses and 86,500 trainees annually, through its 72 Skillnet Business Networks across most sectors and all regions in Ireland. Skillnet Ireland is funded from the National Training Fund through the Department of Further and Higher Education, Research, Innovation and Science.

Skillnet Ireland and Technology Ireland ICT Skillnet developed the Cybersecurity Skills Initiative (CSI) in 2018. The initiative was designed as a direct response to counter the growing volume of cyber-attacks by promoting security best practices and encouraging security technology adoption. Specifically, the initiative will provide cross and upskilling opportunities for IT operatives across all sectors to a recognised standard, allowing them to act as cyber security officers for their organisations, thereby raising the general level of protection across the country.

Since the programme commenced the plan trained over 2,900 people in cybersecurity skills and help 1,400 companies to tackle the cybersecurity skills issues.

The Technology Ireland ICT Skillnet is continuing to promote the importance of Cyber Security programme and provide upskilling programmes and supports to business across Ireland. The below programmes give a indication of the types of programmes which will be rolled out in 2023.
